






Definition of Biblical Worldview

Barna defines "biblical worldview" as believing that:

- absolute moral truth exists;
- the Bible is totally accurate in all of the principles it teaches;
- Satan is considered to be a real being or force, not merely symbolic;
- a person cannot earn their way into Heaven by trying to be good or do good works;
- Jesus Christ lived a sinless life on earth; and
- God is the all-knowing, all-powerful creator of the world who still rules the universe today.

















יֵרֵא yar̂e' – Hebrew Word Translated as Fear

- Used 437 times in different forms in OT
- Fear of God as terror or dread Gen 3:10
- Awe or reverence towards God
- To serve Him and be faithful to Him Josh 24:14-15
- Also includes worship God's people are told to fear Him not other Gods – 2 Kings 17:35-36
- Fearing God is linked to obedience to His law Deut 5:29
- To fear God is having a proper response to His holiness Isa 8:13
- The phrase "do not fear" (ʾ :אַל־תִּירָאוּ: al-tîrāʾ) is used as an encouragement or call for courage
- יבא overall describes a positive response or reverence toward God



THE HEBREW CONCEPT OF WISDOM

קֹבְיֶּהְ (ḥokmâ) וְיִבְּיָהָ (hokmâ)

- The parent root Dnhham, meaning "heat," is the root of the word Dn hhakham which means "wisdom."
- The word *hham* appears in pictographic script as which shows a wall separating water
- The central idea of the Hebrew word for wisdom is one who is able to separate between good and bad
- Wisdom involves both knowledge and the ability to make use of knowledge. Wisdom assumes righteous behaviour, kindness, faithfulness, and loyalty R. P. Nettelhorst, "Wisdom," ed. 

THE FAMILY



- Marriage is designed by God Genesis 2:24
- You have an enemy (and it's not your spouse!!)
- The high calling of husbands Eph 5:25
- "Houses and riches are an inheritance from fathers, But a prudent wife is from the LORD." (Proverbs 19:14)
- "The rod and rebuke give wisdom, But a child left to himself brings shame to his mother." Prov 29:15
- "Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you" (Exodus 20:12).
- Parents don't be tempted to interfere with the law of sowing and reaping – Galatians 6:7

FRIENDSHIP



- Ultimately we should desire to be a friend of God - (Exodus 33:11; Isaiah 41:8; 2 Chronicles 20:7).
- "A man who has friends must himself be friendly" (Proverbs 18:24).
- "A friend is always loyal, and a brother is born to help in time of need" (Proverbs 17:17 NLT).
- "He who walks with wise men will be wise, But the companion of fools will be destroyed" (Proverbs 13:20).
- To be a friend loyalty, confidentiality, time, speaking truth in love, boundaries and choosing friends wisely
- Final tip! Avoid close friendships with friends of the opposite sex
